DISCOVER NANTWICH

On the way a visit to Englesea Brook Chapel



Our trip first takes us to the Englesea Brook Methodist chapel and museum. The museum is the only heritage site to focus on the 19th-century working-class movement that became known as the Society of Primitive Methodists. The Caretaker's Cottage is now a Tea Room, with a Shop and a Reading Room where you can come to study or browse. A charge of £5 pp for a short talk, a guided tour, and tea, coffee and biscuits in the café is included in the price.

We will arrive in Nantwich in time for lunch. Step back in time and enjoy the charms of this picturesque market town, with its medieval street patterns set alongside the river Weaver. There is a wealth of historical buildings for you to explore. Nantwich's claim to fame is St Mary's Church (the cathedral of South Cheshire), one of the finest medieval churches in Britain—a visit is a must.

The shopping opportunities are also excellent. Visitors can hunt down a bargain in the market (Market days are Tuesday am & Thursday all day) or browse in many interesting shops in the centre of town. A good selection of restaurants can be found in the town centre for lunch.
