Enjoy a leisurely drive through the winding lanes and charming villages of this part of Cheshire, making a coffee stop at Bellis Brothers in Holt. Continuing our journey, we pass through the villages of Carden, Tilston and Malpas, close to the border with Shropshire, and visit St. Edith's Church, Shocklach, in the Deanery of Malpas. St. Edith's is a small, isolated 12th century church situated 1 mile outside of the village of Shocklach. It stands on its own in the middle of fields overlooking the River Dee and Wales. Why was the church built so far from the village or if not, why did the village move? See the oldest Norman archway in Britain (so it is claimed).

Later, we visit the nearby Bickerton Poacher. The Pub/Restaurant has excellent food, wine and beers and is a little gem in the heart of the rolling Cheshire plains. A brigade of creative chefs freshly prepares all meals on-site, so there is something to suit all tastes.

We will visit a local place of interest to round off the day.
